From September 2025, your child will start their Key Stage 4 curriculum at St Vincent's School. Key Stage 4 is a two year phase in your child's education. This is an exciting time and we want to support pupils to make choices that will continue to build on their strengths, interest and aspirations for the future.

At St Vincent's School we offer a carefully designed curriculum that balances academic learning, skills development and preparation for adulthood (PfA). Alongside this the curriculum is tailored to meet the needs of pupils with sensory impairments and other needs, including full access to the curriculum framework for children and young people with vision impairment (CFVI).

Pupils will continue to study the following core and foundation subjects:

English

Maths

Science

Computing

Physical Education

Citizenship

Pupils can also study a range of other subjects that may be offered as part of an optional set of subjects.

These subjects may vary each year depending on the specific cohort of pupils. Pupils are guided to follow appropriate pathways which will provide them the best chance of success and prepare them for their next steps in education.

To maintain a broad and balanced curriculum, pupils and parents are consulted in full when exploring options, pathways and subjects. Meaning the offer can vary year-on-year keeping and relevant to the cohort of pupils.

This year pupils will be asked to choose from the following options below:

- · Art and Design or Sport and Fitness
- Music or Modern Foreign Languages
