




Everyone proceeded to walk around the outside of the bombed out church. Sure enough, they spotted a statue!














Chris and Vincy started playing with the football together, laughing and having fun

Without hesitation, the soldiers produced the friendship key!
























DID YOU KNOW?

'All together now' is a statue that captures the remarkable moment in December 1914 when enemy soldiers laid down their weapons and emerged from their trenches to shake hands, sing carols, exchange rations, and most famously, take part in a game of football.

The statue was erected in 2014 to commemorate 100 years since the famous event.





"160 million people have been killed worldwide in conflict since the truce which this statue commemorates. We cannot allow the next 100 years to be like the past 100 years, and I hope that the people who touch this statue will leave transformed and work for peace."
