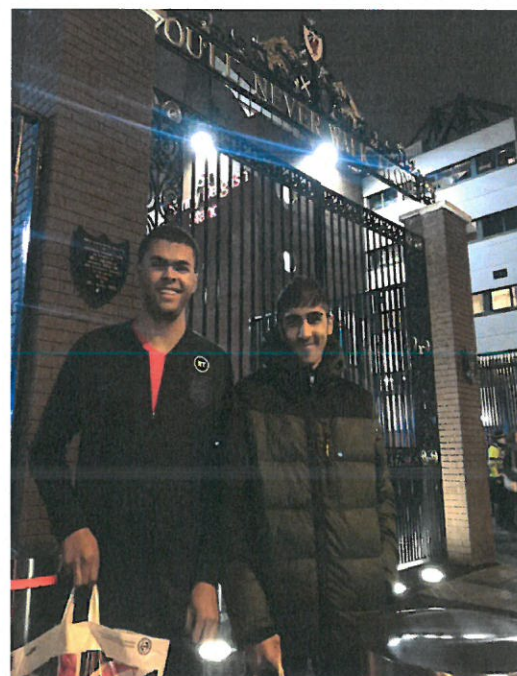

Big thank you to our Governor Mr Keith Burns for the donation of the amazon dots and the chocolates for our residential groups! Thank you again for you continued support.

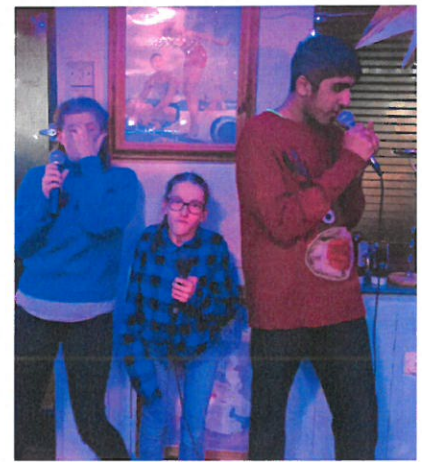


Some of our Duke of Edinburgh students took the time during the Merseyside Derby to drop off food in support for FansForFoodbanks.
