Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents/carers of our PE kit expectations. As part of the National Curriculum, pupils take part in one Physical Education and Swimming lesson per week. Please ensure that your child has the correct PE kit in school on their timetabled PE days. It is advised that your child keeps their kit in school throughout the week in their allocated space.

If, for any reason, your son/daughter cannot take part in PE or swimming a letter must be brought in to school, or a note placed in their Daily Journal. During PE lessons jewellery of any kind, including watches, necklaces and earrings, are not allowed.

Kit should include:

- St Vincent's PE kit
- Swimming costume and towel
- Swimming cap if required
- Swimming goggles if required
- Tracksuit bottoms/top if needed
