A video made with our pupils will be shared at this conference which you will be able to see if you wish to join the conference via the following link <https://www.transform-our-world.org/home>


Alternatively, you may wish to see it on our website in the projects area '**reclaim the green**'. Rather beautifully we have just received a video message support from Alan Titchmarsh.
