Dear Parents/Carers

COVID-19 update

The latest Government guidelines (February 2022) for keeping SEND and specialist settings safe advises staff and pupils in specialist SEND settings to continue asymptomatic testing twice weekly.

As we are a specialist SEND setting with clinically vulnerable children and young people, we are following the Government guidance. So could I please ask for your cooperation in continuing to asymptomatic test your child at home twice weekly? Any pupil who is resident on Wednesday night, with your permission will be tested by our staff.

Although the rules have changed around self isolating with a positive COVID-19 result, I am sure you will agree that if your child has key COVID-19 symptoms or tests positive they should not attend school given the potential risk to others.

School will continue to supply your child with asymptomatic testing kits while this guidance is in place.
