





Everyone crossed over to St George's Hall, the main entrance was blocked off by barriers.






They made it inside and were greeted by a security person!








I did feel very odd and I actually shouted at all my friends and colleagues! It's only the past couple of hours I've been able to think straight and want to

within this building!












The security person led everyone up the stairs

Everyone walked past the statues to see if their keys started glowing






SUDDENLY, the emblem on Will's chest began glowing brightly!












Everyone turned around, revealing ALL of the evil versions of themselves! They had just pixelated into place.










The evil St Vincent's gang crowded around the statue and started touching it... The statue started glowing a deep electric blue!








There was a bright flash of electric blue, and Robert Peel woke up looking baffled and confused... Whats been going on here?? I can spot trouble makers a mile away!

The Emblem shone brightly and projected Evil Will away from Good Will, with a flash that looked like lightning!













Everyone stood together as a team bracing themselves, with Joe being shielded behind everyone as he didn't have a key to protect him.



The evil versions of everyone started charging towards thr St Vincent's gang!








Robert Peel saw Joe being shielded at the back without a Key

DID YOU KNOW?

Robert Peel served twice as Prime Minister (1834 – 1835 and 1841 – 1846)

He Served twice as Home Secretary (1822 – 1827 and 1828 = 1830)

He is regarded as the father of modern British policing, owing to his founding of the Metropolitan Police Service in 1829

Early policemen were given the nickname 'Peelers' referring to Robert Peel's surname but we now know them by the term 'Bobby's' which is of course a nickname for Robert!






Robert Peel

15th February 1788-2nd July - 1850






Everyone stepped outside onto the steps of St Georges Hall, with Robert Peel following behind.





The Liverbirds were flying towards St Georges Hall, holding the peace emblem








Everyone stood in a circle, and their keys started glowing! The keys began flying upwards towards the broken peace emblem




The keys slotted into place, and the cracks on the emblem began healing up.. The emblem was restored!
